## **Dr. Emily Kendall, MD PhD**

Dr. Kendall is an Assistant Professor of Medicine and Epidemiology in the Division of Infectious Diseases at Johns Hopkins University. Her work aims to guide TB control interventions through a combination of epidemiological data collection with mechanistic modeling and simulation. A particular interest is the natural history of subclinical TB, and how its dynamic course relates to transmission and case detection.

### **How important is subclinical TB?**

Her presentation will focus on the epidemiological role of subclinical TB, reviewing what is known and exploring the data gaps that need to be addressed in order to appropriately prioritize active case finding and other interventions targeting subclinical disease.
