Carolyn Samuel, formerly a Senior Faculty Lecturer at the McGill Writing Centre, kept a bank of example assignments—strong and less strong—for students to explore and critique in class. To ensure that she always had enough relevant examples, she sent a version of the email below at the end of every course she taught.
