## **Elective Description**

Rural rotations provide students with exposure to the principles of family medicine practice within a rural setting. During the rotation, the student will work collaboratively with doctors, nurses and other health professionals. The level of exposure for each student will be determined based on experience and level of training.

For rural rotations of 3-4 weeks: Please note that lodging will be provided by the site for trainees who are enrolled in a Medical Faculty in Quebec. These trainees will also benefit from stipends as determined by the Management Framework of the Rural Education Program. These stipends will be distributed by the site to the trainees a few weeks after the end of the rotation.
