Elective Description

An elective, with a minimum duration of 4 weeks, in Anesthesia Research, is offered at the Jewish General Hospital under the direct supervision of Dr. Matthew Cameron. The elective will consist of carrying out a research project. Organization of the project must start <u>at least six months before</u> the elective start date to ensure adequate planning time and ethics approval.

With the help of Dr. Cameron, students will identify a research question and conduct a literature review on the topic, ideally before starting the elective. The time during the elective will be spent collecting data through retrospective chart review or prospective patient follow-up. Students will be given the resources to write an abstract for submission to a clinical meeting and publish a manuscript in a peer-reviewed journal.

Elective Duration

4 to 8 weeks

Educational Objectives

- Expose the medical student to clinical research in Anesthesia
- Understand the advantages and drawbacks of retrospective and/or prospective research
- Submit an abstract to a clinical meeting
- Optional: submit a manuscript to a peer-reviewed journal
