A clinical elective in Orthopedic Surgery is available to interested students. The Orthopedic Service has 36 active beds and deals with a variety of musculoskeletal problems including trauma, reconstructive hip and knee surgery, foot and ankle surgery, spine surgery and some general orthopedics. Weekly teaching rounds, fracture rounds and other conferences are held. There is also a monthly Journal Club. Students will have the opportunity to attend orthopedic clinics, orthopedic offices and the operating room. They will have the opportunity of becoming an integral part of the orthopedic team and become active in all facets of the service. By the end of the rotation, students will have had the opportunity to learn how to perform a good basic musculoskeletal examination, be familiar with radiographic aspects of orthopedics (especially fractures and arthritis), be familiar with general principals of fracture care, arthritis management and management of back pain.
