<b>Elective Description</b>			
<p>Family physicians perform many roles in the context of serving the communities in which they work. Part of this responsibility includes the care of hospitalized patients.</p> <p>During this elective students have the opportunity to work on a hospital ward with a hospitalist family physician. Students work as members of the team providing care for admitted patients while learning how the principles of family medicine apply to the work of a hospitalist.</p> <p><b>Lachine Hospital:</b> Family Medicine wards in a community hospital linked to the MUHC. One physician per week supervision on the wards. Exposure to various in-patient care medical conditions.</p>

<b>Educational Objectives</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Consolidate an approach to common and urgent problems by applying knowledge of etiology, patient history and physical findings to arrive at diagnoses and develop investigation and management plans (MDCM 1.1.2, 1.3.1, 1.3.2, 1.4.1)</li> </ol>			



2. Differentiate between life threatening, serious but non-emergency, and benign conditions, modifying history-taking and the physical exam according to the severity and urgency of the problem, and initiating management appropriate to each situation (MDCM 1.5.1)
3. Report on a clinical encounter (MDCM 1.6.1 & 1.6.2)
4. Demonstrate knowledge of the components of highly effective teams and behaviours that facilitate teamwork. (MDCM 4.1)
5. Demonstrate the attributes of the professional and the healer in the context of patient care. (MDCM 3.1)

Must have completed core Family Medicine Clerkship.

Inpatient care. Daytime only – Monday to Friday 8:00 - 17:30. Possibility of weekend rounding/shifts.

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### Elective Description

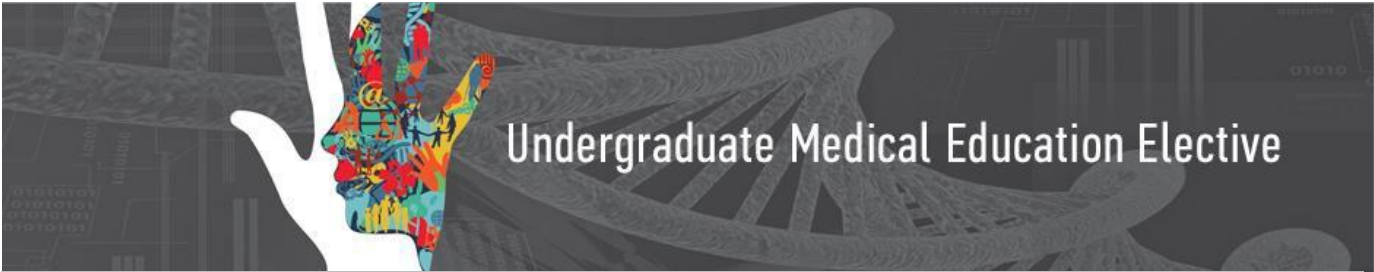
Hospitalization rotation on a unit run by a team of family doctors

### Educational Objectives

Admitting, managing, and organizing discharge of patients admitted on a short-term hospitalization unit in the setting of a family medicine rotation



**Prerequisites**

Interest in being a hospitalist. Completed family medicine or internal medicine clerkship rotation.

**Scope of Work**

Daily rounds of admitted patients, completing the admission of patients awaiting a hospitalization bed from the ER all under the supervision of a hospitalist who is a family doctor.
