

McGill French Language Workshops For Faculty of Medicine Students

Faculty's Commitment:

The language of instruction at McGill University is English. Students are expected to have a working knowledge of the English language (comprehension, spoken and written). All lectures & small groups are conducted in English. Medical students are expected to be functional in French (comprehension, spoken and written) by the time the clinical rotations begin (January of the second year of the MDCM program). Students are in contact with francophone patients in the teaching hospitals and may be assigned to francophone training sites for their clinical rotations.

The Faculty of Medicine is committed to develop Beginners, Elementary and Intermediate French workshop modules. The workshops will be work-related for Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry students

Medical Student's Commitment:

By registering in the workshop, I, the undersigned agree to attend at least 80% (missing no more than 2) of the sessions for which I am registered (attendance records will be kept), and to pay \$250 for the workshop module and placement test. I understand that there may also be some homework to complete.

Students are required to pay \$250 for the workshop module and placement test (\$20 for the placement test, and \$230 for the workshop). Debit and credit cards will be accepted as forms of payment. **Please note that you will not be able to sit the placement test if payment is not made at the placement test.** If you are a True beginner or have already taken this placement test, you do not need to retake the test but you must still register online but the \$20 placement test fee is waived.

Should I need to withdraw, I must advise the French Workshop Coordinator no later than the Monday after the 1st session, in writing. Otherwise, no refund will be given.

The workshops will take place on Saturday mornings, once a week, for a total of 30 hours per module (**September-December 2018 OR January- May 2019**).

Note: A minimum number of students must register in each workshop level in order for any of the workshops to run. A student who misses the first 3 lessons without valid reason will be barred from the remainder of the course.
