### Elective Description

The elective student assigned to the Internal Medicine Clinical Teaching Unit (CTU) will be an active member of the CTU team. He or she will admit, manage, and discharge patients with a variety of medical problems and participate in teaching activities occurring on the CTU. Only students who have successfully completed their core clerkship in Internal Medicine will be considered for the CTU



elective. This elective has limited availability due to McGill trainees being assigned to the CTU as part of their clerkship experiences.

The two acute care medicine CTUs 6 Med and 10 Med will accept elective students to their services as per the following conditions:

- Candidates will have completed training as a clinical clerk in medicine.
- Preferential acceptance will be offered to candidates willing to work 4 weeks on a single 4-week rotation i.e. overlapping periods is discouraged. Three- and two-week rotations are acceptable though less desirable.
- Where there are only two clinical clerks and two junior residents assigned to the service, there is room to accept an elective student.

2, 3 or 4 weeks

**Prerequisites**

Successful completion of core clerkship in Internal Medicine.
