Elective Description

For this elective, the focus of this rotation is mainly clinical. Students are expected to be able to diagnose and offer a treatment plan for most common eye problems.

Emphasis is placed on learning to take a good history, measure the visual acuity and proficient use of the slit lamp and ophthalmoscope.

There is an opportunity for the elective to observe and to take an active part in clinical conferences/teaching rounds when available.
