This is a primarily outpatient experience focusing on the rehabilitation of complex patients. Exposure is mainly to patients with pain conditions, traumatic brain injury and musculoskeletal pathology. There may be some exposure to sports medicine.

Educational Objectives

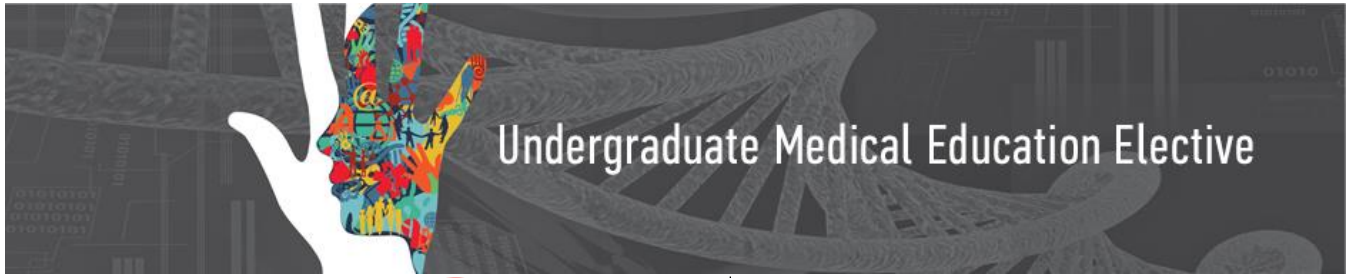
- At the end of this elective, students will:
