### Elective Description

The Douglas Eating Disorders Continuum is a tertiary-care program for the assessment and treatment of people suffering from eating disorders across the life span. The program is dedicated to a tripartite clinical/research/teaching mission. The elective will allow students to participate in the evaluation and treatment of the full spectrum of eating disorders (Anorexia Nervosa, Bulimia Nervosa, Otherwise Specified Feeding or Eating Disorders, Avoidant/Restrictive Food Intake Disorder, and Unspecified Feeding or Eating Disorders), and comorbid conditions (Depressive, Anxiety, Obsessive-Compulsive, Personality and Substance Use Disorders). The student will be involved in all clinical services including outpatient, day hospital and inpatient treatment.

### Elective Duration

2-4 weeks



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
