Elective Description

An elective, with a minimum duration of 4 weeks, in Anesthesia Research, is offered at the Jewish General Hospital under the direct supervision of Dr. Matthew Cameron. The elective will consist of carrying out a research project. Organization of the project must start at least six months before the elective start date to ensure adequate planning time and ethics approval.

With the help of Dr. Cameron, students will identify a research question and conduct a literature review on the topic, ideally before starting the elective. The time during the elective will be spent collecting data through retrospective chart review or prospective patient follow-up. Students will be given the resources to write an abstract for submission to a clinical meeting and publish a manuscript in a peer-reviewed journal.

Elective Duration

4 to 8 weeks

Educational Objectives

- Expose the medical student to clinical research in Anesthesia
- Understand the advantages and drawbacks of retrospective and/or prospective research
- Submit an abstract to a clinical meeting
- Optional: submit a manuscript to a peer-reviewed journal
