Elective Description

Rotation in Pediatric Urology. The student will be directly involved in outpatient clinics, the care of post-operative patients, and ward/ER consultations. He/she will scrub in surgical cases and gain hands on exposure compatible with their level of training. There is daily direct contact with staff for teaching and evaluation purposes.

Elective Duration

2, 3, 4 weeks

Educational Objectives

The student will be able to understand the common urological conditions seen in children such as bladder dysfunction, urinary tract infection, and congenital anomalies of the genitourinary tract. The student will be exposed to surgical and medical treatment options for these conditions.

Scope of Work

The student will be directly involved in the outpatient clinics, ward and ER consultations, postoperative care of patients, and surgical cases in the operating room. There is daily interaction with staff for teaching and evaluation purposes.
