

Elective Description

Available to one student. Elective time in the Department of Urology consists of a clinical experience. Students are integrated with the resident team and are assigned duties commensurate with their abilities. Emphasis is placed on problem evaluation, and the orderly process of urological investigation. Students are taught the elementary skills of catheterization, the principles of modern catheter care and routine endoscopy. Active participation in ward rounds and conferences is encouraged.

Elective Duration


Although we recommend that students come for an elective rotation of 4 week duration, we will consider requests for 2 and 3 week elective rotations.

Available to two Clerkship students who will deal with a wide variety of adult male and female urological disorders. Residents and attending staff provide teaching and the students will participate in the investigation and management of patients as well as cystoscopy, open and endoscopic surgical procedures. The Urology out-patient center, which is open five days a week, will provide exposure to urodynamics, sexual dysfunction, biofeedback and a variety of ambulatory conditions. The residents have their own outpatient clinic where students can participate under their supervision with attending staff. Interested students can also participate in our research program.

Elective Description

Available to two clerkship students. Exposure is provided to a wide variety of adult male and female urological disorders. Students will participate in day-to-day investigation and management of patients and may attend cystoscopy, open and endoscopic surgical procedures. Exposure to urodynamics, sexual dysfunction, biofeedback and lithotripsy is also available.

Teaching will be provided by residents and attending staff and there are five formal urological conferences weekly. The urology out-patient centre will provide exposure to a variety of ambulatory urological conditions. This centre is open five days a week. The residents have their own outpatient clinic on Tuesday and the students are encouraged to participate actively under the supervision of resident and attending staff.

Also, an active research program is available in the urology department and is open to any interested students. Although we recommend that students come for an elective rotation of 4-week duration, we will consider requests for 2- and 3-week elective rotations.
