Dr Michael Patrick Leonard MD, FRCSC Biography

Dr. Leonard received his undergraduate medical degree from Queen's University at Kingston in 1983 and undertook his Urology training in the same Institution. After completing his residency training in 1988 he started a two vear Pediatric Urology fellowship at Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore with Dr. Robert Jeffs. He was initially on faculty at the University of Manitoba. and is currently a Full Professor and academic Pediatric Urologist at the University of Ottawa in Canada's Capital. His clinical research interests include vesico-ureferic reflux, ureferic duplication anomalies and Neuro-Urology. Dr. Leonard has served on the editorial boards of the Journal of Urology, Journal of Pediatric Urology and the Canadian Urological Association Journal. He has been Chair of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Urology Examination Committee, President of the Canadian Academy of Urological Surgeons and Paediatric Urologists of Canada, and is currently President of the Canadian Urological Association. He has also been a Medical Officer at the CMPA, which has given him substantial insight into the medico-legal aspects of surgical practice.
