

WAIN WRIGHT MEMORIAL FUND

Annual Report 1997-98

The Wainwright Fund Committee of the Faculty of Law was composed of J.E.C. Brierley (Wainwright Professor of Civil Law), M. Cantin Cumyn (Chair), N. Kasirer, M.-C. Prémont (Secretary) and Dean Toope (*ex officio*). It held five meetings to administer a budget of \$132,905.66 arising out of a legacy made by the late Arnold Wainwright, to promote teaching and research in Civil Law at the Faculty.

The Committee finalized the revision of its Statement of Granting Policy and Criteria for Attribution of research subsidies. The documents (in English and French) may be consulted in G:\user\everyone\Wainwright.

The Wainwright Committee was instrumental in the establishment of a position of Wainwright Civil Law Librarian. The Wainwright Fund will cover part of the remuneration of the librarian for a period of three years. N. Kasirer represented the Wainwright Committee in the selection process, which led to the position being offered to Me Daniel Boyer, as was recently announced.

The next Wainwright Lecture will be held on October 22nd, 1998. Professor Alain-François Bisson, of the Law Faculty (Civil Law) of Ottawa University, has accepted to give the lecture on the 'Disposition préliminaire' of the Civil Code of Quebec.
